O-R students win technology contest

The freshman technology class at Oldham-Ramona School, along with their teacher Bob Bergstrom, has won \$25,000 worth of Samsung technology for the school by being the statewide winner in a the

Samsung-Solve for Tomorrow contest.

To enter, the class submitted an activity plan outlining what they are going to do for a STEAM (science, technology engineering, art and math) project that could benefit the school and community.

As the state winner, the team will now create a 3-minute video about implementing servers to compete to be one of 10 finalists in the national contest.

All 10 national finalist teams receive another \$50,000 in Samsung technology for their school and the opportunity to present their working prototypes to Samsung's panel of judges."
